This project is an analysis of the media coverage of a current event of your choice, with particular focus on the similarities and differences in the stories among different countries and systems. This project requires you to follow the coverage of an event for two weeks, comparing and contrasting the coverage among two or more countries.

The quantity of coverage should be approximately (either/or):

- Print/digital: 10 news stories or 20 advertisements
- Broadcast: 10 newscasts or 10 commercials
- Social media: 30 posts
- Films/documentaries: 5

You may focus on any aspect(s) of the news coverage and on any media platform (print, broadcast, or digital media; documentaries; films; advertisements, etc.). Examples of aspects are: use of sources, stereotypes in media coverage, media concentration and ownership, influences on media, war and terrorism, foreign correspondence, public diplomacy and propaganda, etc. You should examine these aspects from the perspective of the countries the messages come from.

Your paper should use 12pt TNR font and be double-spaced. The entire document should follow APA 7 rules. You also need to include all the material you used in an appendix.

You may discuss your topic/angle with me to make sure you're on the right track.

Grading criteria

- 10% Introduction (include aspect clearly)
- 20% Material fulfills media type, time, and quantity requirements
- 40% Analysis across the units, focusing on similarities and differences
- 20% Coherence of paper, organization, language, and APA style
- 10% Conclusion
